tasting notes

"Anew Riesling offers an inviting balance of pure fruit flavor, expressive aromas and crisp acidity. The wine delivers aromas of ripe fruit and subtle spice with fresh peach flavors and a clean, refreshing finish." – K.D. Organ, Winemaker

vineyards

- 2014 was a warm growing season in Eastern Washington with excellent ripening.
- Grapes were sourced from vineyards in Washington's Columbia Valley, Horse Heaven Hills, Wahluke Slope and Yakima Valley.
- The region's sunny days and cool nights allow for gradual flavor development and crisp natural acidity.

winemaking

- Grapes were picked under cool nighttime skies to preserve the variety's bright, juicy style.
- A cool three-week fermentation in stainless steel tanks enhanced the ripe fruit characters.
- The blend is almost entirely Riesling, with a touch of Gewurztraminer to bring spice to the palate

food pairings

This wine is perfect on its own or paired with food. Try it with spicy Asian dishes, smoked salmon, lobster salad, pasta with light sauces and blue cheese.
