2020 Guado al Tasso Cont'Ugo

VINTAGE NOTES

- Winter of 2020 was mild with occasional rainfall.
- March saw a sudden drop in temperatures. Despite the cold weather and frost at the end of the month, no significant damage was reported in Bolgheri.
- Temperatures were on the rise in mid-April with favorable conditions that were followed by a hot and dry summer.
- Harvest began on September 3rd and was completed on September 30th.

HISTORY NOTES

- Guado al Tasso, meaning “Badger’s Ford,” takes its name from a common sight at Tenuta Guado al Tasso, Bolgheri, where it is produced.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were hand-picked and carefully sorted prior to crushing. Fermentation took place in stainless steel tanks for 20 days.
- The lots were separated and transferred into barriques. Malolactic fermentation was completed by the end of the year.
- The wine was blended and aged in oak barrels for an additional 12 months. The wine was aged for another 3 months prior to release.

TASTING NOTES

Cont'Ugo 2020 is an intense ruby red color. The nose delivers intense aromas of ripe red fruit, Mediterranean spice and earth. On the palate, a velvety entry is sustained by rich flavors that lead to a long and elegant finish.
