VINTAGE NOTES

- 2021 was a very warm growing season which resulted in intensely concentrated flavors in the wines.
- Our typical cool nights during harvest helped us retain the wonderful natural acidity Washington is known for.
- The season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration and white wines with varietal character and bright vibrancy.

VINEYARD NOTES

- Encompassing more than a third of the state, the Columbia Valley is Washington's largest growing region.
- The grapes were sourced from sub-appellations within the Columbia Valley.
- Sourced from 50% Horse Heaven Hills, 28% Columbia Valley and 22% from Wahluke Slope. 72% came from our own estate vineyards.

WINEMAKING NOTES

- Grapes were de-stemmed and sorted with a cutting-edge grape receiving and sorting system designed to gently remove any stems or leaves.
- Fermented in a concrete tank and was tasted daily to evaluate the development and structure of the tannins.
- Aged for 18 months in 97% neutral French oak, and 3% new French oak.

TASTING NOTES

Grenache can take many forms and with this particular wine I captured many of those facets to form my cohesive vision. Sourced from several vineyards and an array of fermentation techniques this wine has aromas and flavors of citrus, fig, and spice, and it is decadently smooth and refreshingly bright. - Brian Mackey, Winemaker
