Tasting Notes: Enticing aromas of fresh lemon, guava, and star fruit offer an energetic introduction to this wine. Vibrant flavors of mandarin, citrus and white peach intertwine with tropical Plumeria blossoms. A harmonious balance emerges, with zesty acidity complementing warm, fruity undertones.

Winemaking Notes: Sourced from a selection of premium Oregon Pinot Gris vineyard sites within the Willamette and Umpqua valleys, the Erath Oregon Pinot Gris undergoes gentle whole-cluster pressing and stainless-steel fermentation at cool temperatures to ensure a crisp, fruit-forward style. Selective yeasts enhance the fruit flavors as well as structure and balance of acidity, resulting in a final blend with incredible depth and integrity.

Vintage Overview: The 2024 growing season fell perfectly in line with our long-term averages. Optimal bud break, typical spring flowering with April showers, and summer temperatures that provided slow, extended ripening across our vineyards. Months of averages doesn't always sound impressive, but we couldn't have asked for a better growing season. The pace of harvest felt too good to be true – favorable weather allowed fruit to ripen slowly that gave us time and focus at the winery. Winemakers across the Willamette Valley all agreed, this would be a vintage for the ages.
